Current Operations: Barnett Shale

Dale's efforts in the Barnett Shale play are concentrated in the urban areas of Tarrant County. The company's initial leasehold position was assembled in the floodplain of the Trinity River in 2003 and currently includes over 117 drill site locations. Each pad site is designed to accommodate multiple horizontal wells.

Dale has leased in excess of 35,000 acres acquired from numerous mineral owners, including the Amon Carter Foundation, Trinity Waste, Texas Industries, Bell Helicopter (Textron), DART, City of Arlington, Tarrant Regional Water District and the Arlington Independent School District, Tarrant County Community College and Fort Worth Independent School District.

Dale successfully bid with the City of Fort Worth for Gateway, Tandy Hills, and Quannah Parker Parks, as well as Mallard Cove Park and the Northeast Landfill.
